1. June 30 – July 3 ~ Kick Off To Summer!

2. July 7 – July 11 ~ Luau Week

A week of dramatic play and Hawaiian traditions ending off with a special Luau and treats!

3. July 14 – July 18 ~ Ocean Adventures

Introduction and exploration of the ocean and ocean life.

4. July 21 July 25 ~ Classic Camp

Children will experience nature and camping in it's traditional form through setting up camp and dramatic play using "real life" camping equipment. They will learn camp songs, tell stories, build a "pretend" fire and enjoy special snacks.

5. July 28 – Aug.1 ~ Imagination Station

A week that encourages individuality and supports the child's imagination. Children will guide and determine the course of activities in a creative setting that encourages individuality and imagination.

6. Aug.4 –Aug. 8 ~ Silly Science

Field Trip Schedule

Week 3 Friday, July 18th - **Drama Kids** Presents ~ A 45 minute Ocean Fun Adventure – Hop on a submarine and travel underwater to visit our friends at the bottom of the sea.

Week 4 Friday, July 25th - **Project Nature** ~ Wild About Turtles – This program will help children think about their connection with the Earth and other creatures using real live turtles, songs, poems and creative art activities.

Week 5 Friday, August 1st. - **Steve Thomas Magic** ~ A 30 minute interactive children’s magic show.

Week 6 Friday, August 8th - **Mad Science** Presents ~ Energy In Motion – Preschoolers will learn all about energy and motion in this hands on program. They will discover that energy can be stored; some basic laws of motion and how things move. They will get to experiment with ribbon dancers, tube racers, “Slinkys” and get to take home an energy toy called a “Boink.”

Week 7 Friday, August 15th - **Drama Kids** Presents ~ Egbert’s Amazing Hat Adventure – Egbert has lost his magical hat! Children enter a magical forest where life is unusually tall AND small to find Egbert’s hat.

Week 8 Friday, August 22nd - **Project Nature** presents ~ “What Do You Do With A Tail Like That?” Children will discover the amazing things animals can do with their ears, eyes, mouths, noses, feet and tails in this beautifully illustrated interactive guessing book.
